


TANTE BLANCHE MUSEUM NEWS


The "Tante Blanche Museum" was opened from mid-June to mid-September from 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. on Mondays through Fridays and on Sunday afternoons. Despite the recessionary woes, visitor and income statistics reveal a continuous increase. Students numbered 488 and visitors numbered 1,460 for a total of 1,948 visitors. Artifact donations continue to be of inestimable historical value. The continuous demands made upon our limited facilities make expansion imperative. List of artifacts is attached.

We lent fifty artifacts that appeared on the NBC Go-USA Bicentennial Program entitled "Silent Eye".

The Society published a brochure entitled "Tante Blanche Historic Museum".
